To acknowledge this too often silent epidemic -- and to foster a conversation among women and men about how it can be stopped -- Terror at Home: Domestic Violence in America offers a report from the streets, police beats, and both modest and spacious homes, putting a real-time lens on domestic abuse, the escape and the complex aftermath for women and their families. The documentary is a key component of Lifetime's Emmy award-winning advocacy outreach campaign "Our Lifetime Commitment: Stop Violence Against Women."

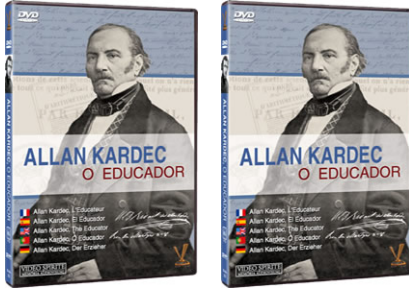
Narrated by the famous Iranian actress **Shoreh Aghadashloo**, who was nominated for an Oscar for her role in "House of Sand and Fog".

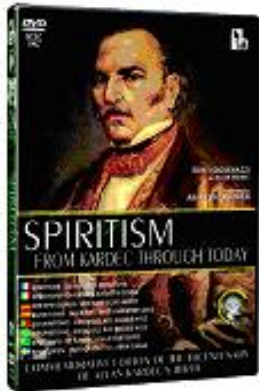
## ALLAN KARDEC, O EDUCADOR
